GOSPEL – John: 13, 31-33a. 34-35

When he had gone out, Jesus said, "N ow the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once." Little children, I am only a little longer. I give you a new commandment: that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples: if you have love for one another."

We deepen the Gospel

The first sentences of this text are like a set of variants on the word "glory"; As Judas departed, Jesus declared: "Now the Son of man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him, God, in due time, will give him his own glory."

It is this text, according to Jesus; it is at the moment when Judas leaves at night to betray him, that he, Jesus, fulfils his vocation of being the reflection of the Father. We see that, reflecting, John has understood that, in reality, it was the hour of the glory of Jesus: because it is there where the Son revealed how far the Father's love goes.

It is in the second part of our text when those who contemplate that mystery of God's mad love become capable of loving as He loves, Jesus unites the two things well: first he says "now, I am going to reveal to the world how far love goes of the Father" and then if "now I give you a new commandment, which is to love in the same way". And this, completely guided by his Spirit.

We are therefore invited in the first place to an act of faith!: To believe that his Spirit inhabits us, that his resources of love inhabits us that, from now on, we have the capacity to love, that it is possible for us to love "like" Him because his Spirit acts in us.

Jesus is not unaware of the difficulties that this entails, but love and sensitivity must not be confused: Jesus comes to show with acts how we should love; let us remember the context: the action takes place during the last supper with his disciples. Jesus begins by washing their feet, the fact surprises them: He, the Lord and Master, becomes their servant. And Jesus ends by saying: "This is the example that I have given you; what I have done for you, do it also". Thus loving "as" He loved us... and, after all, if we reflect on the fact, it is possible to serve one another, even with those with whom we are not attracted to.

Meanwhile, we must never forget that victory cry of Jesus on the day of the last supper: "Now the Son of man is glorified (that is: revealed as being God), and God is glorified in him", humanity is introduced in the glory of God, in the presence of God, in the life of God in the event of the Passion-Death-Resurrection.

-How do I dialogue with God with what the reading tells me? (Sentence)

-How do I feel the presence of God in my life? (Contemplation)

-How do I put into practice the message of the word of God in my real life? (Action)
