GOSPEL - John 1, 1-1

"In the beginning there was the Word and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. She was in the beginning with God. Everything was done through her and without her nothing was made that exists. In her was life and life was the light of men, and the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not overcome it. There was a man, sent by God: his name was John. He came for a testimony, to bear witness of the light, to that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but the one who should bear witness to the light. The Word was the true light that illuminates every man who comes into this world. He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world did not know her. She came to her house, and her own did not receive her. But to all who received her, she gave power to become children of God, to those who believe in her name: she was not born of blood nor of the desire of man, but was born of God, and the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we have beheld his glory. A, glory that he receives from the Father as the only Son, full of grace and truth. John bears witness to him and cries: "This was the one I said about: He who comes after me has stood before me, because he existed before me." For of his fullness we have all received and grace for grace. Because the Law was given through Moses; Grace and truth have come to us through Jesus Christ. No one has ever seen God: the only Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, he has counted."

We deepen in the gospel

In the beginning there was the WORD. What Saint John tells us here is capital: the entire Creation is the fruit of the dialogue of love between the Father and the Son.

The vocation of humanity, of Adam, according to Genesis, is to live a perfect dialogue of love with the Father. But human history, unfortunately, shows the opposite. The account of the fall of Adam and Eve, in the second chapter of Genesis, tells us in its own way:

Understand that the dialogue broke down. That is right, the man and the woman distrusted God. They suspected that God had bad intentions regarding them. The opposite of the dialogue of love! We all know something about that: when suspicion crosses our relationships, dialogue is poisoned. And in our personal life, the history of our relationship with God could be represented in the same way: As soon as we are turned towards Him, as we turn our backs on Him. It is necessary that we turn around towards Him and thus our dialogue can be resumed

"Turn around", this is the meaning of the word "conversion" Christ, perfectly lives that dialogue without shadows with the Father and his only objective is that all humanity can enter into that dialogue of love. "Those who believe in his name" are those who have confidence in him and who follow him. "May they all be One as you, Father, are in me and I am in you, may they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me" (Jn: 17:21). "The opposite of sin is not virtue; the opposite of sin is faith."

To "believe" is to have confidence in the Father, to always know, whatever happens, God is kind. Never suspect God. Never doubt God's love for us and for the world... and of course, look at the world with his eyes.
