**GOSPEL – Mark 10, 2-16**

"Just then some (Pharisees who wanted to test him) came and asked him, 'Can a husband send away his wife?' He answered them, "What has Moses commanded you?" They answered: "Moses has allowed signing a certificate of separation and then divorcing." Jesus said to them, "Moses, when he wrote this rule, took into account how stubborn you were. But at the beginning of creation, God made you male and female; with his wife, and the two will be one flesh. So that they are no longer two, but one. What God has joined together, let no man separate. When they were already at home, the disciples asked him again about the same thing, and he said to them: "Whoever separates from his wife and marries another woman commits adultery against his wife, and if the wife abandons her husband; to marry another man, she also commits adultery. Some people brought the children to him so that he could touch them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, he became indignant and said to them: "Let the children come to me and do not prevent them, because the Kingdom of God belongs to them. those who are like them. Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God like a child will not enter it. "Jesus took the children in his arms and, laying his hands on them, blessed them."

Internalizing the Word of God today (Marie-Noëlle THABUT)

Genesis 2, 18 - 24. We are in the first chapters of Genesis, facing a writing called "wisdom", that is, not historical but for reflection: in the tenth century before Jesus Christ, probably, at the king's court Solomon, a theologian, is assailed by questions like: "Why death? Why the suffering? Why the difficulties between couples? And all the "whys" of our lives, which we face very often... To respond, the theologian tells a story, in the same way that Jesus told parables. The author is not a scientist, but a believer: he does not intend to tell us the when or how of Creation. It simply says the meaning of God's project.

Psalms 127/128. Regarding our psalm 127 (128), here is the structure that can be detected in it: it is presented as a dialogue between the priests and the pilgrims; In the first part, the priests, and the entrance to the Temple, welcome the pilgrims and give them a final catechism: "Happy is the man who loves the Lord and who walks according to his rules!" Our thirst for happiness for humanity, our desire for family success, joins God's project for us...God has created us for happiness and nothing more. Let us rejoice

Hebrews 2, 9-11. This text is, in some way, a small summary of the Christian creed. It says three things: first, that Jesus is, at the same time, man and God; second: that Jesus is the Savior, the Messiah we were waiting for; and third: that, through his death and resurrection on the cross, Jesus brings salvation to humanity.

Mark 10, 2-16. At that time there were laxists and also rigorists. The Pharisees therefore come to Jesus to ask him the question: "Is it permissible for a man to divorce his wife?" What is wrong with this question? Mark notes that the Pharisees' intention is to test Jesus. He was expected to respond with a yes or no. But, as usual, Jesus does not answer directly, but rather helps his interlocutors to seek the answer themselves.

To begin, he sends them to the Law of Moses: "What has Moses commanded you?" In reality, Moses has not prescribed anything on this subject. Divorce existed in custom and the act of repudiation was established. Is the trap set by the Pharisees there? "Let's see if Jesus knows the Law well" But Jesus goes much further. His response places it on another ground! "Because of your hardened heart, Moses has formulated his rule." Jesus makes us understand that the Law was a pedagogical stage of God because, when we are in the kingdom, we will only know one law, the law of love. And the kingdom is not for later, it is in our midst.
