Then we gathered in groups to begin the journey of 'conversation in the Spirit', a synodal dynamic, and a form of deep and prayerful dialogue that will guide us in seeking God's will for the Congregation.

At the tables of conversation, we introduced ourselves, gathered concerns and evaluated if we have had the effective time for reading and personal reflection of the document. After listening to different opinions, it was decided to continue the personal study and reflection and tomorrow we would have the first space for spiritual conversation.
