Let us live the signs of times with faith, united to the Mother of the Lord, let us welcome the Word and open our hearts to the grace of the Holy Spirit who fills his Church with his gifts.

Hymn: "VENI CREATOR"

Come, Holy Spirit, Creator blest, and in our souls take up Thy rest; come with Thy grace and heavenly aid to fill the hearts which Thou hast made. O comforter, to Thee we cry, O heavenly gift of God Most High, O fount of life and fire of love, and sweet anointing from above.

Reading from the Acts of Apostles 2, 1-11

"When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sit-ting. Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each. Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs-in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power".

Leader: We take as a model the testimony of Mary of Nazareth, listener of the word, qualified believer, first disciple, humble protagonist, active follower, hopeful witness of God's liberating action over all humanity. Her witness helps us to review, update and celebrate a new Pentecost today:

Docile woman

Perhaps this is the key to understanding all the mystery and the greatness of the mother of Jesus. To say yes to the Spirit, not once or twice ... but always. A permanent, updated, renewed and happy yes. "Open to God in the emptiness of her being and available for the service of the Kingdom, in the joyful acceptance of her condition as a servant, she is the Consecrated Woman, the faithful Virgin".

Woman of silence

Silence to interiorize, to fill the mind and heart with everything that comes from God, from his Presence and from his Word. Silence also to welcome everything that comes from the people, their deepest longings, sufferings and hopes. "She lovingly welcomed us, encouraged our first steps and opened us to the mission".

Woman who listens

She listens the voice of the Spirit, to learn from Him, to know the way, to find the answers to know how to say, with all her soul: "Do whatever He tells you. "Mary, the humble woman, , available to the Lord's plan, teaches us that the strength of the Kingdom is not in power and wealth, but in the wonders that God does in the hearts of the simple".

GIFT OF WISDOM

It is the gift of understanding what favors and what damages God's project. He strengthens our charity and prepares us for a full vision of God.

GIFT OF UNDERSTANDING

It is the divine gift that enlightens us to accept the truths revealed by God. Through this gift, the Holy Spirit allows us to search the depths of God, communicating to our hearts a particular participation in divine knowledge, in the secrets of the world and in the intimacy of God himself. The Lord said: ""I shall give them a heart to acknowledge that I am Yahweh..." (Jer 24,7). May the gift of understanding reach to all women who do not want to have children, to all those who cannot have children and want them, to those who abandon or mistreat them.

GIFT OF COUNSEL

It is the gift of knowing how to discern the paths and options, of knowing how to guide and listen. It is the light that the Spirit gives us to distinguish right and wrong, true and false. The Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus and gave him this gift in fullness, as Isaiah had prophesied: "His judgement will not be by appearances, his verdict not given on hearsay. He will judge the weak with integrity and give fair sentence for the humblest in the land." (Is 11, 3-4).

May your Counsel God enlighten the hearts of women who are abused, those who die victims of violence.

GIFT OF KNOWLEDGE

It is the gift of the knowledge of God and not the knowledge of the world. Through this gift the Holy Spirit reveals to us the mind of God about us, because "nobody knows the qualities of God except

the Spirit of God ." (1Co 2, 11). «After saying this he breathed on them and said: Receive the Holy Spirit.». Jn 20,22

May the gift of Science guide the minds and hearts of women who, living in extreme poverty, struggle and seek the means to come up, those who want to be protagonists of the development of their countries, societies but they are not allowed and are killed.

GIFT OF PIETY

It is the gift that the Holy Spirit gives us to be always open to the will of God, always seeking to act as Jesus would act. In the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians he wrote: "Now in regard to spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you be unaware. You know how, when you were pagans, you were constantly attracted and led away to mute idols. Therefore, I tell you that nobody speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus be accursed". And no one can say, "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit." (1Cor. 12, 1-3).

May the gift of Piety enlighten women leaders who, seeking the good, defending life and family, know how to discern what comes from God and what doesn't come, leading with righteousness and fidelity on the way that leads to an authentic knowledge of the Truth, being witnesses of your Kingdom.

May the gift of fortitude, Lord, assist women who, in solitude, ignored, misunderstood and sometimes abused, strive to support their family, their children ...
