GOSPEL – Luke 12, 49-53

"I have come to bring fire on the earth and how I wish it were already kindled! I have baptism with which to be baptised, and what stress I am under until it is completed! "Do you think I have come to bring peace to the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division. For from now five in one household will be divided, three against two, and two against three; the father will be divided against the son and the son against the father; the mother against the daughter and daughter against mother, mother-in-law against daughter-in-law, and daughter-in-law against mother-in-law." "

We deepen the Gospel:

To describe his mission, Jesus compares it to a fire: "I have come to bring a fire to the earth and how I would like it to be already lit" Quickly, the consequences of the announcement of the Good News could be measured, both in the Jewish world and among the pagans. Starting from the fire of Pentecost, this announcement is like a fire that spreads at full speed both on the dry grass and in the forest: in the Jewish people, it seems to destroy religious buildings, in the pagan world, it is considered as a contagion without reason: Saint Paul writes to the Corinthians and tells them: "We preach a crucified Messiah, a scandal for the Jews, madness for the pagans" (1Co 1,23). The fire is of such magnitude that it leaves indelible marks: those who allow themselves to be enlightened by the proclamation of the gospel and those who reject it become hopelessly antagonistic, even if they are united by family ties.

When Jesus announces these tears, it is not, for him, the expression of a premonition, no: Jesus speaks of experience. Let us remember the episode of the visit to Nazareth. Luke tells us: "Jesus, with the power of the Spirit (the Spirit of fire) returns to Galilee" (Lk 4, 14), and it is known that one of the first little lives he made was to Nazareth in his youth. After a moment of enthusiasm, his childhood friends and closest relatives turned against him because, speaking, he even told them that his mission went far beyond the borders of Israel. That's right; the fire lit by Jesus leads us to opt for radicalism. "Do you think that I have come to bring peace to the world? No, I have not come to bring peace but division"... It may shock us, but we have forgotten that peace is not achieved with a blow of a wand magic. Peace calls for a radical conversion of the human heart and it is this conversion that many will oppose with all their might. Sent to the lost world to speak of love and **God's Salvation**, Jesus has encountered suffering and death just as he himself had announced. But his Resurrection must give us all the encouragement we need: the Spirit has been given to us and covers us. It is up to us to spread that fire!

- What does the text Say? (Reading)
- What God is telling me through this text? (Meditation)
- How do I dialogue with God with what the text tells me? (Prayer)
- How do I feel the presence of God in my life? (Contemplation)
- How do I put into practice the message of the Word of God in my real life? (Action)
