GOSPEL – John 15, 9-17

“As the Father loved me, I also have loved you; remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. I have told you this, so that my joy may be in you, and your joy may be full. This is my commandment: that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than that which he lays down his life for his friends. You are my friends, if you do what I command you. I no longer call you servants, because the servant does not know what his master is doing; I have called you friends, because everything that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. You have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain; so that whatever you ask the Father in my name he will grant you. What I command you is to love one another.”

Deepen the text (*Marie-Noëlle THBUT*)

It is necessary to consider the importance of the first phrase of our text Acts 10, 25ff: “Peter arrives in Caesarea to the house of Cornelius, a centurion of the Roman army...” Luke specifies that the Spirit himself reassures Peter about what he is going to do. : «Peter was always worried about his vision, but the Spirit told him: here are two men looking for you. Go quickly to find them and walk with them without causing problems because I am the one who sent you.” Decidedly, the Church always progresses thanks to the Holy Spirit! Psalm 97 (98) speaks very well of what we could call "The two loves of God": his love for the chosen people...And his love for all humanity, what the psalmist calls "the nations"...

Let's read verse 2: “The LORD has made known his victory and revealed his righteousness to the first letter of John 4, 7 – 10, talks

about love in almost all of its paragraphs! It is therefore in line with the rest of the readings for this Sunday.

If Paul speaks like this, it is because the community to which he writes, (and which can be placed at the end of the first century), is in crisis. It seems that the false prophets disoriented minds with endless theological discussions. And, meanwhile, the community forgot the essentials. In this text, Saint John makes the members of his community return to what is essential, that is, God, that is, Love. And, if it were necessary to summarize this passage, one could simply say: God is love and all human love comes from God.

"I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that you may all be filled with it." This is the good news of this text!

According to this periscope, taken from chapter 15 of the Gospel of John, in which Jesus speaks to his apostles to fill them with joy. And the reason for this joy is that the life of Jesus has been nothing more than love for the image of the Father: "As the Father loved me, I also have loved you." We are exactly in line with the second reading: when humanity finally knows God, as he is, humanity will be filled with joy. The more we read the Bible, the more we may be struck by this insistence: humanity's only problem is that it does not know God and that it is wrong about Him. Humanity takes Him to be a terrible Judge, and God is a Father who rejoices. of the joy of their children.
