GOSPEL – Luke 2, 22-40

"When the day appointed by the Law of Moses for purification arrived, they took the child to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, as it is written in the Law: Every firstborn male will be consecrated to the Lord. They also had to offer a pair of turtledoves or dove chicks as a sacrifice, as ordered by the Law of the Lord. There lived then in Jerusalem a man named Simeon, who was just and pious, and hoped for the consolation of Israel. The Holy Spirit was in him and had revealed to him that he would not die before seeing the Messiah of the Lord. Led by the same Spirit, he went to the Temple, and when the parents of Jesus brought the child to fulfill with him the prescriptions of the Law, Simeon took him in his arms and praised God, saying: "Now, Lord, you can let him May your servant die in peace, as you have promised, because my eyes have seen the salvation that you prepared before all people: light to illuminate the pagan nations and glory of your people Israel. His father and mother were amazed by what they heard about him. Simeon, after blessing them, said to Mary, the mother: "This child will be the cause of fall and rise for many in Israel; It will be a sign of contradiction, and a sword will pierce your heart. Thus the intimate thoughts of many will be clearly manifested." There was also a prophetess named Anna, daughter of Phanuel, of the family of Asher, a woman already advanced in years, who, married in her youth, had lived with her husband seven years. Since then she had remained a widow, and was eighty-four years old. He did not leave the Temple, serving God night and day with fasting and prayers. He showed up at that very moment and began to thank God. And he spoke about the child to all those who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem. After fulfilling everything that the Law of the Lord commanded, they returned to their city of Nazareth, in Galilee. The child grew and became stronger, full of wisdom, and the grace of God was with him

To deepen the Word today (Marie-Noëlle THABUT) MALACHIA 3:1-4. To a community, tired of waiting for "the day of the Lord," Malachi announces two comings: That of the Precursor and that of the Lord.

PSALM 23. May the Church fully open its doors to meet the One who arrives.

HEBREWS 2,14-18. God and man are inextricably united in one person: Jesus Christ, who is the only perfect Priest, Mediator and Savior of all.

LUKE 2, 22 – 40. We find Luke's first message in this text of the Presentation of Jesus in the temple of Jerusalem: "It is within the framework of the Law of Israel in which the salvation of all humanity has seen the light... It was in this framework that the Word of God was incarnated... in a word, that God's loving design towards humanity would be fulfilled." Afterwards, Simeon enters the scene driven by the Spirit; and it is the Spirit who inspires Simeon with the words that reveal the mystery of that child: "My eyes have seen your salvation." Let's take up Simeon's phrases one by one: "My eyes have seen the salvation that you have prepared for all people": The Old Testament is the story of this long and patient preparation of the salvation of humanity carried out by God. It is, without a doubt, about the "salvation of humanity" and not only of the people of Israel: it is exactly what Simeon requires: "light to enlighten the nations, and glory to Israel your people." The glory of Israel, precisely, consists in having been chosen, not by itself, but by all humanity and, to the extent that history progressed, the Old Testament discovered, more and more, that the salvation project of God concerns all humanity.
