GOSPEL – John 14, 23-29

"Jesus said to his disciples: "If anyone loves me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him. Whoever does not love me does not keep my words. And the word you hear is not mine, but the fathers who sent me. I have spoken these things to you while still being with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of all that I have said to you. Peace, I leave with you, my peace I give with you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid. You have heard that I said to you, 'I am going away and will come back to you.' If you loved me, you would rejoice that I am going to the father, for the Father is greater than I. And I am telling you now, before it happens, so that when it does happen, you may believe."

To deepen the Word today (Marie-Noëlle THABUT)

Acts 15,1-2.22-29

The assembly of the "Council of Jerusalem," aware of the assistance of the Holy Spirit, made a decision inspired by concern for unity and charity in communities composed of converts from Judaism and paganism. The mission begins!

Psalm 66:2-8. One Lord. Jesus Christ leads the multitude of peoples to the Father of all. Universality is a fact!

Rev 21:10-14, 22-23. The Old Testament, with the names of the twelve tribes above the gates, and the New Testament with the names of the twelve Apostles on the foundations, will give cohesion to the "city to come." It is the future open to salvation!

John 14:23-29. John describes Jesus as sovereignly free. It is Jesus who reassures his disciples, not the other way around! Not only does he know what is going to happen, but he accepts it and does nothing to escape it. Jesus announces to them that he is going to leave, but he presents the case as the condition and the beginning of a new presence"I am going away

and I will come back to you." The fact that Jesus leaves will be interpreted later, after the Resurrection, as Jesus' Passover. John himself says in chapter 13: "Before the Passover, Jesus, knowing that his hour had come, the hour to depart from this world to his Father"... John uses this word deliberately, because it is well known that Passover means "passage." "If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father." And this is not the first time these expressions are used: a little earlier, when Philip asks him: "Show us the Father," Jesus calmly replies: "He who has lived has seen the Father" (In 14:9). In other words, he is the One Sent by the Father, he is the Word of the Father. From then on, the Spirit will be the one who makes these words understood and will engrave them in the memory of the disciples. Because the key to this text is probably found in the expression "word": yes, we see it repeated several times, and if we refer to what has been said before, we cannot doubt it; this is "the word" that must be absolutely observed, the word that defines the "commandment of love": "love one another." That is so, and our greatest misfortune is forgetting that the essential thing is to love one another and serve one another. It is normal, then, that the Spirit of love instills in Christ's disciples the will to maintain unity, whatever the cost.
